Administrative/Biographical History:

Bisexuals of Colour was formed at BiCon London in 2010 – a year after a racist incident before BiCon 2009 by one of the conference organisers. A few founding members talked that year about what it would look like to have a safer space for the minority within a minority at the longest running bisexual event in the world. Back then there were only five bisexuals of colour in attendance at BiCon in 2009, but the following year there were many more. Twelve sat in a room, shared, cried and made connections. It was the start of something special.

Founding member Jacq Applebee produced the Bi's of Colour History report in 2015; the first of its kind. Bisexuals are often erased in studies about Black people, and they are also erased in studies about LGBT+ people too. History, when it comes to both People of Colour, and Bisexuals, has one thing in common: it is denied that they existed in the past. Projects such as Medieval People Of Colour has shown art portraying non-white people in Europe for over 800 years. However the art is still often dismissed by die-hard racists, who do not want to believe people of colour have always been in the UK. When it comes to bisexual people, a similar thing happens: they are written out LGBT history, erased as either straight or gay. Through the survey and the report, Applebee attempted to combine the two strands in recording the histories of people who identify as non-white and non-monosexual

Bi's of Colour spent the next decade bringing the world information about bisexual lives, providing practical support to their members, and having stalls at LGBT+ events where members sadly faced biphobia and racism in droves. But members also found our white allies who supported them and spoke up when others tried to silence them. UNISON, the trade union, helped them produce physical media, Leeds Bi group and BiPride were also supportive during rough times. As of 2021, Bi's of Colour have disbanded.
