MATTERS ARISING:

<u>Public Meeting:</u> About I00-I50 people attended the meeting which was enjoyable and moving. The collection raised £I32.70. Ray expressed thanks to Dave and Polly and the anonymous man at the Town Hall who helped with the seats.

Mineworkers Defence Ctee; Mike J had attended County Hall at stated time but there had been no meeting. There was confusion about whether or not L.G.S.M. has been invited onto organising ctee., matter was defered till clarified.

Welsh Congress: Mark Ashton will report back in two weeks.

Publicity Group: Pub Group put forward the following propsals:-

I: That L.G.S.M. should agree in principle to the production of a pamphlet.

2: If above agreed members of L.G.S.M. should submit proposals to pub gp.

3: Responsibility for the pamphlet should rest with the publicity group, with report backs to general meetings.

These proposals led to a discussion of whether L.G.S.M. needed a pamphlet, a leaflet or both. It was agreed that the Leaflet would be discussed as a seperate agenda item. It was then agreed that people should approach the pub. group with ideas and info for the pamphlet and that there should be further discussion next week. A request from the pub group for funds to produce headed notepaper was agreed. It was suggested that there should be a logo - all ideas welcome. John McKay agreed to produce sticky address labels for press contacts. The publicity group will contact all gay groups re the 24th Feb demo. Ray G. proposed that we advise organisers of our participation to avoid being put at end.

Leaflet: There was a discussion of how a leaflet to give out when collecting could best be written. Monty, Reggie and Roddy agreed to produce a draft for the next meeting.
