Authorisation to collect: Martin is waiting for a reply from Dulais Bank-bags Treasurers to bring cash-bags from bank to next meeting Public Meeting Sub-group Report Back: Harworth, Dulais, LGYS/LCGR are now confirmed. T. Benn and D. Skinner have still not replied but Paul C. would try to contact them personally at the L.P. Conference in Blackpool during the coming week. C.L.P.'s and C.P.'s have been /are being contacted for funding Stalls - various organisations are to be contacted to see if they want stalls (the foyer/reception area at Conway Hall is large and would hold ten to fifteen tables, they also have a stack of tables which they will put up if we want them). Security: all members are urged to attend the meeting and be vigilant of the possibility of attacks on people coming to, at or leaving the meeting.

Dulais Valley Sub-group Report Back: The wub-group discussed attitudes and the purpose of the visit. 34 people had shown an interest in the visit. It was felt that hiring a coach and driver would be too expensive as the drivers accommodation, food and wages would be included. Mark reported that Southwark Unemployed Centre would not be able to provide us with their mini-bus that weekend (26-28th Oct). In view of the probelms around transport the sub-group had made a contingency plan for two separate visits. This would also mean that collections could still take place when one half off the group was in Dulais. Mike had made a provisional booking with Hackney Community Transport. They would be able to hire us their 12-seater minibus from Friday 26th (pm)till Sunday 28th (pm). In order to qualify we

must affiliate to H.C.T. (£2.50 p.a.) and the driver must take their driving test for insurance purposes. The hire rate is 25p/mile (including petrol). Calculating the round 'trip at 400 miles this works out at £8.34p/person. Mike to affiliate L.G.S.M. to H.C.T. (Driving test booked Thurs 4th Oct ? MJ) mike to also try to book their mini-bus the following weekend (2-4th Nov) this will necessitate another member also taking their driving-test and driving the second contingent down to Dulais (MJ - this booking has now been provisionally placed, H.C.T. however, cannot guarantee that they will be able to test our driver in time for the second trip. If possible they will - would any L.G.S.M. member with a licence over twelve months, with no reported accidents within the last three years and who is available 2-4th Nov, please contact Mike a.s.a.p. to arrange a test with H.C.T.) Susannah to try to get National Campaign Against the Police Bill to sponsor the visit, Mike to supply Susannah with hire rates. The sub-group reported that L.G.S.M. members visiting Dulais may be levied in order to pay for transport, if NCAPB can't sponsor. Derek, Ray and Reggie to be added to list of members going to Dulais. Monty to check with British Rail and National Coaches regarding return fares and discount for group.booking (RM - reports B.R. too expensive, National Coaches £11.50 return/£13.50 by Rapide, (4/10))
