Administrative/Biographical History: Martin Weaver began working within the community response to HIV and AIDS in the UK in 1983, when he joined Terrence Higgins Trust (THT) as a volunteer. He took the first phone call on the helpline and worked to support HIV and AIDS sufferers and their family and friends, before he was later appointed as THT's first Press Officer. He then moved on to work in the National Health Service (NHS) across various roles including with Paddington and North Kensington Health Authority, and the AIDS Education Project, before eventually training and working as a psychotherapist. As part of his role as Press Officer at THT, Martin recorded as many programmes as he could from the period that covered HIV and AIDS in the media and mainstream culture, which amassed to what he calls his 'AIDS Archive', and in 2021 he uploaded the majority onto his [youtube channel](#) which serves as a resource to map the community response to HIV and AIDS in the UK.

The interviewer was Phillip Hodson. Many studios also had problems when I or other gay men, regardless of our AIDS status, were on programmes and studio staff refused to work with us. We worked hard to educate people and by and large we succeeded.'

[Weaver: “As the Press Officer for Terrence Higgins Trust (THT) I was asked to go and speak to the cast, to tell them about our experience. I visited the Royal Court Theatre one afternoon to sit in on a rehearsal. As I recall the scene played out on stage was one set in the rooms of the Gay Men’s Health Crisis (GMHC) in New York and was a depiction of energy, confusion, turmoil and some panic. As I said to the cast it gave a very good impression of what walking into the THT rooms must feel like to an outsider. We talked about the message of the play and I said to the cast that they would be sought out for comments to back up all sorts of moral and political positions – especially Mr Sheen who was playing the main character Ned Weeks, a character based on Larry Kramer himself. My suggestion to them was to keep to the human side of the story – people under threat, friends dying, creating needed services, responding to a crisis and building a stronger community.”]
