It was not helping the culprit in any way to conceal the fact as if he were checked at this age, he would probably give up the practice & so benefit for the rest of his life. <sup>Mr Gilbey</sup> ~~He~~ gave the example of a boy for whom he found a job. This boy stole money while at work & was caught with a marked six pence: he, afterwards, was glad that he had been found out because he had thus been stopped before he grew too old to break himself of the vice.

Further, Mr Gilbey said that a Club member only gets out of the Club what he puts into it. The boy who takes an interest in it & takes up many activities gets far more enjoyment from the Club than the boy who sits by the fire & expects his pleasure to come to him without working for it.

He ended his speech by saying that he thought the spirit in the Club was better than when he first came to it in 1908.

The Annual General Meeting was held on Friday, Sept 27<sup>th</sup>. Mr. G. Gilhey in the Chair supported by Mr. Howarth, Mr. D. Shastromsky, Canon Holmes, Dr. Holmes, Mr. E. G. Hartley, Mr. F. Hartley, the Instructors & members of the Boys Club.

The minutes of the previous annual general meeting were read, approved & signed.

Mr. Gilhey addressed the meeting, speaking first of the loss that had befallen the Club in the death of Jimmy Payne. He then touched upon two unpleasant subjects: — the abuse by a few members, of Club property and the pilfering & stealing from the dressings which occurred from time to time. He reminded the boys that, if any one of them were in trouble, he had only to go to one of the Managers who would do anything possible in order to help.

Mr Ernest Hartley spoke next. He told the Club that the Deaborough Cup had been won for the 5<sup>th</sup> year in succession with 96 points, Stobton Manor being second with 86 points. 106 members had taken part in the various Deaborough Competitions & these were invited to the Deaborough Dinner which would be held on December 2<sup>nd</sup>. Mr Hartley then said that the House Competitions were not supported as they should be & it might prove necessary to keep a register of those boys who did nothing in the Club. The White House Dinner would be held on November 26<sup>th</sup>. During the past year (1<sup>st</sup> Oct 1934—27<sup>th</sup> Sept 1935) 207 Probationers had been admitted; 181 new members elected; 49 members had gone up to the Old Boys' Club on reaching the age of 18. 131 members were struck

off the Club register for arrears of subscription. 5 members had, on leaving the neighbourhood, been transferred to the supernumerary list. The membership of the Boys' Club was 368.

Canon Holmes spoke at Mr Gilbey's request, praising the fine appearance & good physique of the members present.
