

The Annual General Meeting was held on Mon. Oct 9th. 1944 at 8.30 p.m. Mr. Villiers in the chair supported by Sir. E. Howarth. Messrs. G. Jackson, A. A. Thompson, A. Hayes, G. M. J. Smith, E. Stanley, & W. Rawlings, boys club, & a few old boys & veterans. Minutes of the last Annual General Meeting were read by G. Jackson and signed by the chairman. Mr. Villiers said that now Mr. Hartley had left the club it was the duty of members to do their utmost to back Mr. Jackson & Mr. Thompson. He explained Mr. Hartley's reason for leaving the club, and told members they owed a great deal to Mr. Hartley for the good work he'd done these past years. He welcomed suggestions from the boys, such as running classes on crafts etc. Mr. Jackson for the benefit of newer members explained rules of the boys club: subs. fines, boys c^{tee} and captains. He said that in future every activity will have its representative on the c^{tee}. He hoped this year's house comps will prove more successful, he told the boys to support the Indoor Competitions. He warned members who weren't taking an active part in the club. He asked members to take a personal interest in the W^{ness}, not to be afraid to challenge people who they thought had no right being there. He hoped the dental clinic would be starting soon and invited boys to use it. He appealed for more members for the girls club. He reminded

members about writing to the club when they are in H.M.T.s. Mr. Villiers asked House Capts. to introduce the c^{tee}. The c^{tee} was introduced as follows: D. Blue: S. Glover Capt. (Football), W. Errington V. Capt. R. Delemere (Indoor Games), G. Barnes (Otters). L. Blue: L. Wills. Capt. (P.T.), W. Law. V. Capt. (Running), W. Turner, W. Rawlings (Boxing). Football & Cricket. Mr. Thompson said that during the past year we've been running 2 teams Sat, & 2 Sun at cricket but towards the end of the season we had to drop to one team Sat. owing to the lack of players. Players should make more use of the nets during the week. Last season we ran 4 football teams, both Senior & Junior teams were undefeated in the league but were knocked out in the 1st. round of the cup. We hope to have 4 teams again this season, he stressed the importance of the 'a' teams, not only were the matches themselves important but the players were sometimes called on for the other teams. Footballers should be very fit and should take advantage of the other classes. Care of footballs, capt. of teams will be held responsible. If a boy is down to play and cannot turn up he should notify the club or Mr. Thompson. He concluded by hoping for a good season. Running. E. Stanley said he was speaking in the absence of W. Boulter now in H.M.S., he said we were rather unfortunate in the fed. cross-country losing

our 2 best runners to the forces, however we gained 4th place. In the athletics we did quite well coming 2nd to Watling St. He invited members who supported other activities to come running for training particularly footballers, he said they will have a running class every Wed. evening from the club at 10.30 am. from the W'sters. Swimming. G. Jackson said we'd started the season with a large fixture list for the earliest part we were successful but then came the bombing which caused all other junior swimming clubs to close down, we kept going by organising inter-House comps and entering for County championships. L.Blue defeated R.Blue in the House Comps. The team race Junior team were runner-up champs in the Southern Counties team race. In the Fed. swimming we won practically everything he said he was proud of the team, not for winning but for the splendid way the team & reserves turned up. He invited members to the coming galas. He thanked Morris 'Pop' & Eddy Huston for their grand help, and praised the good work done by Stan Brown the former swimming Hon. Sec. now in the forces. At the request of the chairman S. Brown (on leave) came onto the stage for a few words, he said the others had a grand record and it was a grand feeling to know that the boys kept it going during the absence of the elder members. P.I. & Gym. C.S.M. Smith said people regarded P.I. as a minor activity whereas it was the most

important of all. He said there was more in P.I. than people thought. He gave a short talk on anatomy explaining how P.I. strengthens the heart. Some people thought a hard day's work sufficient exercise, this he contradicted because it only developed certain muscles, properly organised exercise was necessary. He concluded by saying that he'd taken classes in both the Army and clubs but he was genuinely sincere when he said he'd never enjoyed taking a class more than the class at ^{the} Manor. Boxing. W. Rawlings Before W. Rawlings commenced the chairman said he'd just received a letter from Mr. D. Shaw-Kennedy, Mr. Kennedy's disappointment over the lack of boxing these days was expressed in the letter. Mr. Rawlings said this past year had shown an improvement. We had one junior div. champion and one Fed. champ, with the present talent he saw no reason why we shouldn't go further this year. He said he'd write to Mr. Kennedy to keep him informed of the boxing. He concluded by thanking Mr. Jacobs & who was welcomed on the stage and said he was only too pleased to help the boys, he said he'd been connected with club boxing for 20 yrs. and had seen some good boys and hoped to see many more. Gadets. A. Hayes spoke of successes in both the cadet work and the sporting side. He said Mr. Thompson felt very proud when at a big parade the Brig. Gen. congratulated

the Manors Unit on being the smartest on parade. He said that many cadets had passed Certificates Cadet work would be beneficial to the boys in later years it would teach them leadership. He said that 5 Manor Cadets were chosen to represent London Cadets last year and five again this, and no less than 5 had been given the honour of playing against the A.T.C. at Lord's: Sir E. Howarth commenced his speech by correcting last year's minutes he said he'd been with the club 25 yrs. not 20.

He said that during these times elder members were dragged out like museum pieces to help keep the young ones going, but they were doing a grand job, he hoped the boys would back them up. In a final address by the chairman he asked members if they had any questions to ask. Mr. Jackson said the C^{tee} would like to collect for a present for Mr. F. Hartley, this was agreed upon. There being no further business to discuss the meeting was declared closed at 9.110 p.m.
