Liddell, E.A. Wilson, K.S. Duncan, G.H. Jackson, F. Lee, R. Hill, various Hon. Secretaries, and 9 trustees, ^{and over 300 members.} Minutes of the previous A.G.M. were read by E.A. Wilson, approved by the meeting, and signed by the chairman. There was no business arising from the minutes.

The chairman read letters of apology for absence from Sir Edward Howarth, R. Shaw Kennedy, & A.J. Barnes. He also read a letter from Sir Charles Wrench, regretting his inability to attend owing to illness, which was particularly tragic, as it was written shortly before his death. The chairman took the opportunity of expressing the club's sorrow at his passing, and gave a short history of the great work Sir Charles had accomplished for the Federation. The chairman also said that Mr. Villiers was away in Europe and was unfortunately unable to be present at the meeting. The chairman in a short speech asked members to take particular care of club property and equipment, he asked members to get to know each

other, and to support the many activities. He spoke of the many amenities of the sports grounds, and said that it was always open for members.
