Name of Creator: History Workshop Centre for Social History (HWCSH)

Extent: 31 Folders

Administrative/Biographical History: Opened in February 1984 in a 19th century terraced house across the road from Ruskin College, this provided a bricks and mortar home for History Workshop, offering a base to amateur and professional historians, students and teachers, local history and other groups. Under the general supervision of the History Workshop collective, the small permanent staff organized events, produced newsletters, and ran two summer schools. Despite support from Ruskin College, the Centre's finances were precarious, and it ceased to exist as a separate entity in 1987. The Centre also acted as a 'brand name' for History Workshop publications and events.

Custodial History: Transferred to Bishopsgate Institute from Ruskin College, 2012.
