BOWMAN Aubrey Bowman 1931-2010

Name of Creator: Bowman, Aubrey Clement (1918-2009) musician and Communist

Extent: 11 boxes

Administrative/Biographical History: Aubrey Clement Bowman was born in 1918 and educated at the Royal College of Music. As a student, Bowman trained with the composer Alan Bush, of the Independent Labour Party. Through the course of his studies, Bowman became increasingly involved with the London Labour Choral Union and the Workers Music Association. He stood as conductor and music composer for the Workers Music Association beginning in 1936 and had a successful independent career in music conducting for the London Festival Ballet, Sadlers Wells Theatre Ballet (later The Royal Ballet) and the National Ballet of Canada.

Bowman joined the Communist party in 1941 and remained active throughout his lifetime, supporting the Soviet line on Hungary (1956) and Czechoslovakia (1968). Later in his life, Bowman supported a variety of political campaigns, most notably: nuclear disarmament, anti-racism, community controlled education, and the liberation struggles of Latin America.

Bowman married Lalage Bowman in 1950 and fathered two daughters. He died in 2009.
